#### Topic of the ToT2

Setting up and managing a center of excellence (entrepreneurship knowledge centers)

#### **General information about ToT2**

The training aims to build up knowledge and share experiences made among the partners from Europe, Bhutan, Laos and Nepal. The knowledge generated supports all partners with the implementation of the upcoming work packages and tasks within the project.

In addition, the trainings combine theoretical input sessions which are combined with practical sessions, applying the learnt to support the implementation of the project. The content/format includes ppt presentations, interactive exercises, polls, good practice examples, etc., group work, reading materials, follow-up work, etc.

The training is planned for a duration of 3 days, starting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and finishing on the 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2022. The online sessions with the partners from Europe will always start at **8:30am CET** and last between 4-5 hours. In addition to these sessions, partners from Bhutan, Laos and Nepal will need to gather together (face-to-face or online, depending on the circumstances) in their university teams or in their country teams to finish the open tasks to be presented to the whole ToT2 team the following day, if necessary.

It is of highest importance to involve all partners to the same extend. It is a non-aim of these trainings to only include European perspectives in the trainings. Cultural diversities need to be considered while implementing ToT2 but also all upcoming trainings.

Given the current Covid-19 situation which is still affecting the implementation of the ENCORE project, it was decided that ToT2 is implemented as an online training. Wherever possible, partners within one country will meet at one place (preferably, the one of the national coordinator) to be able to grow together and exchange knowledge and views. Travel budget and costs of stay is available for those who travel.

#### **Training participant specifications**

Training participants need to be engaged with the entrepreneurship knowledge center implementation in the respective universities. Therefore, the training participants should be the following:

- Higher education management representatives engaged in the ENCORE centers
- Project coordinators of ENCORE and the entrepreneurship knowledge centers (EKCs)
- EKC staff including director
- EKC student coordinator/students working within the EKCs

It is essential that people who will be <u>actually engaged</u> with the ENCORE centers take part within this training as this training is also very much connected to work package 4 which deals with the operations of the entrepreneurship knowledge centers.
