General information about ToT3 & 4

The training aims to build up knowledge and share experiences made among the partners from Europe, Bhutan, Laos and Nepal. The knowledge generated supports all partners with the implementation of the upcoming work packages and tasks within the project.

In addition, the trainings combine theoretical input sessions which are combined with practical sessions, applying the learnt to support the implementation of the project. The content/format includes ppt presentations, interactive exercises, polls, good practice examples, etc., group work, reading materials, follow-up work, etc.

ToT3 is planned to be held in Graz/Austria at FH JOANNEUM from the 3rd until the 6th of May 2022 and will be combined with a project management meeting. ToT4 is going to take place in Alicante/Spain at University of Alicante. All sessions start in the morning and will then last until the late afternoon – please see schedule below.

Both trainings will be the first ones implemented face-to-face.

It is of highest importance to involve all partners to the same extend. It is a non-aim of these trainings to only include European perspectives in the trainings. Cultural diversities need to be considered while implementing the two final trainings.

Through the implementation of the trainings, it is also believed that team building can be enforced and a stronger commitment in terms of collaboration can be achieved.
